













Amati and Italy Trivia Fortune Teller

1. Cut out the square below and place the printed side face down on a hard surface. Fold each corner towards the centre so each picture is visible on top. Press firmly on all folds and flip the square over.
2. Repeat the same step, folding each corner to the centre. Press firmly on all folds.
3. Fold the small square in half, unfold, and the re-fold the square in half the other way.
4. Slip your fingers underneath each of the pictures and test your Italian trivia!
