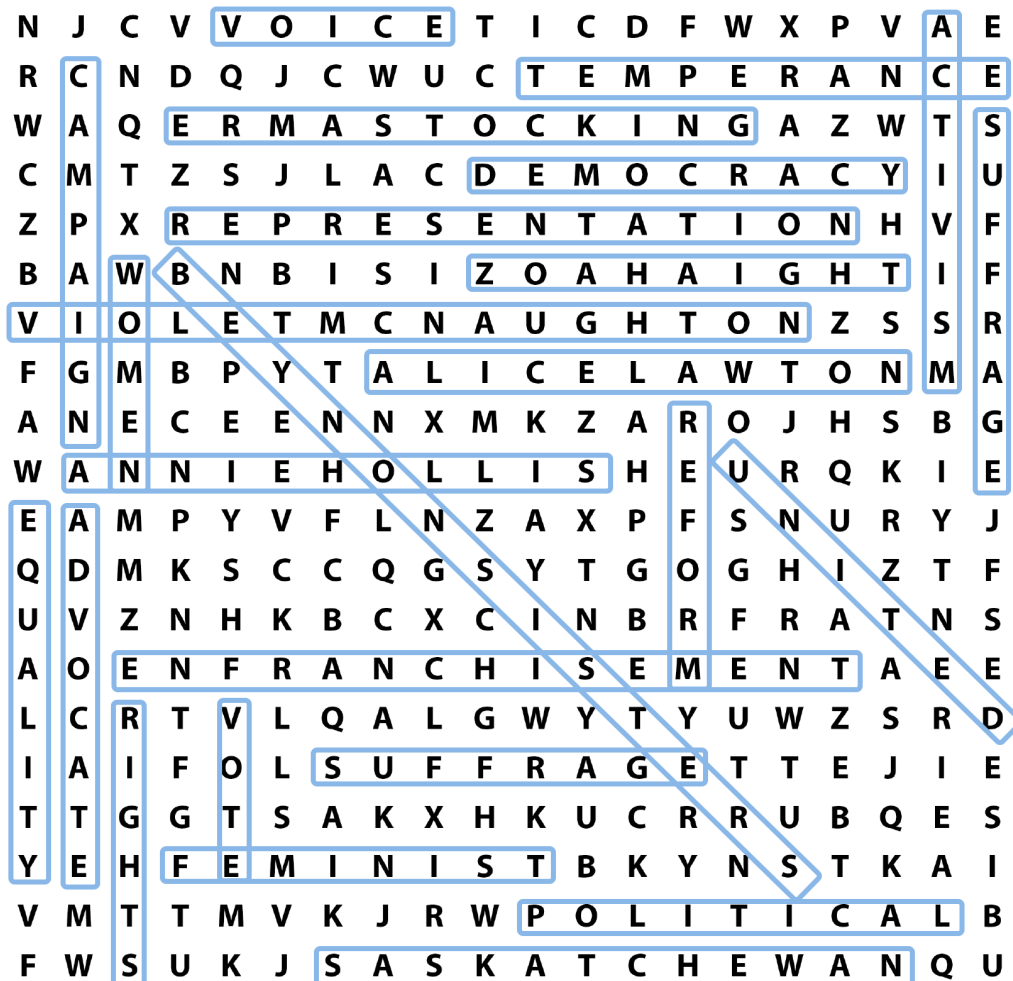


# Sisters United Word Search
