OTTAWA TO VISIT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, I SEND
YOU WITH HUMBLE DUTY A MESSAGE OF LOYALTY AND LOVE FROM
ALL CANADIANS.

"DURING THIS HISTORIC STAY, YOUR MAJESTY HAS STRENGTHENED IN US ALL OUR PRIDE IN CANADA AND IN CANADA'S QUEEN.

"IT IS WITH HIGH HOPE THAT YOU WILL COME
TO US SOON AGAIN THAT I BID YOU AU REVOIR; MAY GOD
BLESS YOUR MAJESTY AND PRINCE PHILIP."
